#### CONTRIBUTIONS

Contributions are **PRE-TAX** or **TAX DEDUCTIBLE**



#### GROWTH

Earnings and interest invested in mutual funds grow **TAX-FREE**



#### HEALTH

Withdrawals for eligible medical expenses are **TAX-FREE**



Eligible medical expenses include medical, vision, dental and prescriptions

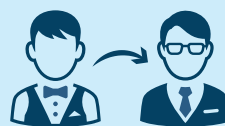
