

## **The Eleanor G. Jones Marion College Scholarship**

### **Application for Funds in Support of Experiential Learning Opportunities**

**Notice of Funding Opportunity:** The Eleanor G. Jones Marion College Scholarship funds the enhancement of experiential learning opportunities of students in a qualifying program of study. The program funds research, internships, service-learning, study away, and/or creative/artistic works.

#### **In order to qualify for these resources:**

1) Students must be declared in one of the following programs:

- Art Major/Minor
- Art History Major/Minor
- Arts Administration Concentration
- Music Studies Concentration
- Theatre Major/Minor

2) Students should have begun the coursework in their declared program of study, including at least two completed credits and enrolled in a third credit.

#### **Applications will be reviewed by a committee of faculty in the area programs. Criteria for evaluation include:**

- 1) A written proposal, authored by the student and mentored by an area faculty member.
- 2) Project must have an experiential learning component (examples may include: research, internship, service-learning, study away, creative/artistic works, festivals, workshops, conferences, publications).
- 3) Overall quality of the proposal.
- 4) Faculty determination that the proposed project is manageable and can be completed as proposed.

#### **Proposal process:**

- 1) Prepare a written proposal of approximately 300 words. The proposal should define and describe a project/or experiential learning opportunity that the student intends to complete and for which the Jones Scholarship could provide necessary support.
- 2) Complete the budget chart (see page two).
- 3) Timeline for the completion of the project.
- 4) After completing steps 1 through 3, the student should seek mentoring from an area faculty member.
- 5) Completed materials should be submitted to faculty mentor in the area. These materials must be submitted as attachments in either Microsoft Word or .pdf format.

Proposals will be accepted on a rolling basis. A first review of applications will occur on October 1 in the fall semester and February 15 in the spring semester. Funds cannot be guaranteed for any term, nor does an application guarantee an award of the scholarship. Please talk to any of the area professors as soon as possible to discuss funding and the application process.
