

Interviews: If you are a Senior Education major, interview with school systems who have openings for the 2024- 2025 school year for teaching and licensure paths.


Career Booths: Visit booths hosted by professionals from different areas of the education sector. Gain firsthand insights into day-to-day roles and career options.

Join us for the Health Careers Expo!





2024 Fall Paid Research Opportunities

The Office of Science / US Department of Energy is pleased to announce paid research internship opportunities for undergraduate students majoring in areas of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) for the Fall of 2024. The application system for the 2024 Fall Term Science Undergraduate Laboratory Internships (SULI) program is currently open, with all applications due by 05:00 PM Eastern Time on May 22, 2024.

The Science Undergraduate Laboratory Internships (SULI) program places students from 2 and 4 year undergraduate institutions as paid interns in science and engineering research activities at DOE national laboratories and facilities, working with laboratory staff scientists and engineers on projects related to ongoing research programs. Appointments are for 16 weeks during the Fall term, are open to US Citizens and US Lawful Permanent Residents, include a weekly stipend, reimbursement for one round trip domestic travel to the participant's host DOE laboratory, and possibilities for a housing allowance. More than 850 internships are sponsored annually.

John Hudson Internship Program

The application for the John Hudson Internship Program (JHIP) has now been posted: <u>John Hudson Internship</u> <u>Program Webpage</u>.

The Fairfax Area Disability Services Board established JHIP for college students and recent graduates with disabilities. The internship program provides participants with on-the-job experience, professional development, and training opportunities. Any college student, law student, graduate student, or recent graduate who self-identifies as an individual with any type of disability may apply. This year's internship program includes one internship in IT and one internship in the Alcohol Safety Action Program.

The internship program lasts 380 hours and pays \$15.48 per hour. The start and end dates are flexible, but interns should plan on starting work in the beginning of June and working until the beginning of August. This is a full-time internship (40 hours/week). Interns should plan on working eight hours a day (with a one-hour lunch break), Monday through Friday. A typical schedule is 8 a.m.-4:30 p.m.

The submission deadline to me for the application, resume, and two letters of recommendation is Friday, April 12, 2024.

Summer Internships at LEAP

Interns for Local Environmental Agriculture Project (LEAP) will support our nonprofit's mission by assisting in the daily work of our mobile and fixed-site farmers markets, community gardens, shared commercial kitchen, food hub operations, and/or marketing efforts.

LEAP internships will be designed to fit each intern's schedule and interests, while taking into account the specific needs of our organization (which change depending on seasons and other factors).

Interns will report to LEAP's Food Access Manager, Community Gardens Manager, Kitchen Manager, Food Hub Manager, and Communications Manager, depending on the schedule that is co-created by LEAP and the intern. This is an unpaid internship. Interns are encouraged to learn as much as they can about LEAP's work in Roanoke and beyond during their internship, which includes taking home local fruits and vegetables as available.

LEAP is also hiring a full-time <u>Administrative Services Manager</u> and <u>Community Garden Manager</u>.
