

Expectations of a Medical Maroon Scholar

Scholars must be working toward a career in a health-related field but are free to pursue any major(s) offered on campus. (No expectations or restrictions with regard to major.) Students who elect not to pursue a career in a health-related field during their first three years will be asked to surrender the scholarship the succeeding year. Students who elect not to pursue a career their senior year or after graduation will not be required to repay the scholarship if they choose to pursue a different path at that time.

Requirements:

At minimum, scholars must maintain a 2.0 minimum overall GPA.

They must meet with their assigned Health Career Advisor at least once each semester.

They must attend at least one event sponsored by the Center for Health Careers each semester (e.g., a CHECPoint seminar, the Health Careers Expo, the Hylton Lecture) and commit to one community service or health-related outreach project each year.

Satisfaction of these requirements must be documented by the Scholar and shared with the Coordinator of the Healing Horizon Scholars program by April 15 of each year.

Scholarships are renewed at the end of each academic year after determination that the requirements have been met by the Scholar. A notification of warning may be sent to the holder on or before March 1 if adequate participation has not been made to date.
