Award:

The award will be distributed as determined by the proposal. The monies will be distributed in advance to fund the costs of the project (scripts, royalties, materials, etc.) Monies for travel may be distributed in advance, or, afterwards as a reimbursement. Money may be distributed as a check. For May Term, off-campus IL courses, money will be a direct deposit. (Money for Off-campus classes cannot be used for the deposit.)

You must submit a report at the conclusion of your project. The project will determine what needs to be documented. Appropriate documentation of the project and the budget should also be included in the final report: receipts, mileage, photographs, final reflections, etc.
