Moving Beyond Sedation: Innovations in Emergency Psychiatry



Dr. Zeller is the vice president of psychiatry for Vituity where he is responsible for overall strategy and business development of the practice. He is the former chief of psychiatric emergency services of the Alameda Health System, which is based in Oakland, CA and one of the busiest psychiatric emergency departments in the U.S. Dr. Zeller is an assistant clinical professor at both the University of California-Riverside and Touro University medical schools, and is past-president of the American Association for Emergency Psychiatry. He is the author of several textbooks and numerous peer-reviewed articles on emergency psychiatry. Dr. Zeller is a sought-after leading expert in emergency psychiatry and is a keynote speaker at numerous state, national, and international conferences. During his tenure with Vituity, Dr. Zeller has consulted on 30+ hospitals and state associations regarding behavioral health projects. His focus is advocating to providing better care at the appropriate time for psychiatric patients. This work has evolved into creating sustainable psychiatric emergency care in coalition with hospital systems, county amenities, and state associations. His leadership is helping to shape emergency care for psychiatric patients which frees up time for emergency departments to focus on providing better care for all.
